Three projections comprise the installation, where one video (far right) and two data projections are presented as a triptych. The central projection enables the participant to navigate through a 150-image panorama with text superimposed over the images using a track ball to navigate and make choices.

Both an English version and a German version were authored.

Clicking on a word with the track ball led to a dynamic poem generator presented on the center screen.

All of the words in the poem generator were hyperlinked to a particular image, leading to their original context in the poem

Each modular poetic text had an associated video segment that could be triggered and played on the right hand screen. If selected, that particular section of the text would be spoken and a section of music would play along with the video.





The left screen was a machinic poem generator that used the vocabulary of the poem on the right to continuously generate new lines of poetic text.
